

Question 3. # 4.5.15 (marks) Given the plane  $2x_1 - x_2 + 3x_3 = 5$ , and the line  $\vec{x} = (3,0,4) + t(-1,1,1)$ ,  $t \in \mathbb{R}$ , determine if the line is parallel to the plane, orthogonal to the plane, or neither parallel nor orthogonal. If the answer is "neither", determine the angle between the direction vector of the line and the normal vector of the plane.
